MISSISSIPPI DOE ENTERS INTO \$1.2 MILLION AGREEMENT WITH CLASSROOM CONNECT FOR READING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

BRISBANE, CA — January 7, 2005 — Classroom Connect, an educational technology division of Harcourt Inc., announced today an agreement with the Mississippi Department of Education to create a comprehensive online professional development program for K-3 *Reading First* early literacy instruction. The company will create a series of online courses entitled “MS First” for Mississippi’s 535 elementary schools to present participants with knowledge of reading instructional theory and the utilization of instructional strategies based upon scientifically-based reading research.

Much of the *MS First* online content will be custom-made to the state’s specific criteria and will feature video examples of exemplary teaching practices from Mississippi’s master teachers.

“States and districts face enormous challenges meeting the professional development requirements of the *Reading First* initiative,” said Jim Bowler, President and CEO of Classroom Connect. “Mississippi is to be credited with taking this challenge seriously and developing a combination of online and traditional in-person workshops that will best equip the state’s reading coaches to improve reading instruction throughout the state.
